As part of our grant from the Southwick Cultural Council, Our Community Food Pantry is sponsoring an art contest for students, ages 5-19, in Southwick, Granville, and Tolland, MA. Prizes will be awarded at the kick-off to the Southwick Library summer reading program on June 25th.

The content of the submission must be about farms or farming in our community. The artwork can be any art media the student artist wishes to use. Examples include drawings, paintings, photographs, three dimensional work, dioramas, or any other art media that our artists choose to incorporate in their artwork.

Prizes: First place prize of \$35 for each of 3 categories

Second place prize of \$25 for each of 3 categories

Categories: Awards will be made by age categories by age categories: 5-8, 9-12, and 13-19

Deadline for submissions: May 31, 2022; winners will be announced by June 15th on our website

Official Contest Rules:

- The content of the artwork must be about farms or farming in our community.
- The contest is open to all students in the Southwick, Granville, and Tolland communities (not post-secondary students) in the following age divisions: 5-8, 9-12, and 13-19.
- Students may submit only one entry of original, creative artwork. An “Entry Release Form” must accompany the submission.
- The art may use any non-perishable media the student wishes to use. Only photographs of the artwork should be submitted. Photographs should be submitted to the following email address: OCFPboardofdirectors@comcast.net
- Questions regarding this contest should be emailed to the address listed above.
- A parent or guardian must sign the entry release form located at the bottom of the Entry Release Form. Students 18 or older may sign the release form. The entry release form will give Our Community Food Pantry permission to post photographs of pantry-selected submissions along with student initials on our website and to display submissions at the Southwick Library in August 2022.
- The pantry will send an email to confirm receipt of the entry. However, if a confirmation email is not received by the entrant, it is up to the entrant to confirm that their artwork was received by Our Community Food Pantry.
- Prizes will be awarded at the kick-off to the Southwick Library summer reading program on June 25th. A first-place prize of \$35 and a second-place prize of \$25 will be awarded for each of the three categories.
- Deadline for submissions is May 31, 2022. Winners will be notified by email and in writing prior to the presentation of prizes. Winners, along with photographs of their submissions, will be announced on our website by June 15th. Winners will also be posted on the community information board at the Southwick Public Library. Only the initials and age category of the contestants will be available to the public.
